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A Public hearing was held at 5:45 pm to hear views on the Proposed FY'20-21 budget. The floor was opened to the audience for questions or comments about the budget. Mayor Landreneau adjourned the public hearing. The audience had no questions about the budget other than to agree with the information presented.

Proceedings of the Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council were held on Monday, November 16, 2020 at Washington Town Hall, 405 N. Washington, St. Washington, La.

Members Absent: Mr. Ledet

A motion was made by Ms. Wilson to approve the minutes of the last meetings and seconded by Ms. Doucet. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Mayor Landreneau gave an FYI on the graves that were damaged in the cemetery due to the two storms. He said that FEMA representatives and the Attorney General Office indicated that the town was eligible for funding to repair the graves. Each grave that was damaged will need a sponsor. FEMA will hire a contractor because the project is public assistance; all sponsor checks will have to be sent back to the Attorney General's Office to pay the contractor.

The mayor gave an update on the garage sale that was given by Ms. Johnnie Fontenot. The garage sales were \$925.00. The funds will be used to pay off one of our vendors Bodemuller's.

A motion was made by Ms. Wilson to adopt Ordinance #6 on 2020, the FY' 20-21 Budget and seconded by Mr. Malveaux. All were in favor and motion passed.

Chief Latoya Trent gave her report on Blue Line Solutions which deals with the Electronic Traffic Enforcement Program. She gave the total count of speeding violations for various days.

Ms. Tanya Doucet introduced Ordinance #7 of 2020, the Speed Control Electronic Traffic Enforcement Program.

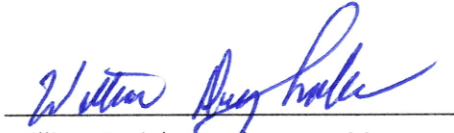
